Selection shall be with reference to the qualifications, achievements and merit of the candidate, and not mere "winnability" at the polls (not more than 100 words)		The candidate was selected based on his exceptional qualifications, including a strong academic background and extensive experience in public service. His achievements in successfully implementing public policies have positively impacted the community. Demonstrating leadership, integrity, and commitment to public welfare, the candidate merit lies in his proven ability to address key issues and drive meaningful changes. The selection was made on the basis of his competence and achievements, ensuring that merit, not mere "winnability," guided the decision.			
3.	Reasons as to why other individuals without criminal antecedents could not be selected as candidates (not more than 100 words)		Other individuals, while free of criminal antecedents, were not selected due to their relatively limited qualifications, experience, and accomplishments compared to the chosen candidate. Saryu Roy demonstrated a stronger track record of leadership, public service, and problem-solving abilities, which made him better suited to address the pressing needs of the community. In addition, the other candidates lacked the same level of proven competence and ability to deliver impactful results, making them less favorable choices for the role.
